

Full-Day Workshop for Every Working Christian

Why we offer this workshop

It is often difficult for Christians to know how best to live out their faith at work, with the result that their lives are often separated into "work" and "personal" segments.

This workshop is designed to help attendees understand what it means to be a Christian "out there" in the workplace – in ways that are simply not possible to teach from the pulpit on a Sunday morning.

HELPING EVERYONE KNOW HOW TO BE A CHRISTIAN AT WORK


Based solely on the teachings of the Bible, this workshop gives a solid foundation and a series of practical steps for every working Christian to live out their faith at work.

What is it?

This full-day workshop is a combination of lectures, workshops and group work:

Why work matters to God
What your purpose is at work
What God expects
How to handle tough situations
How ambition fits into God's design
What it means to be a Christian at work

The workshop draws solely on the Bible, including many character examples from the Bible that deal with many of the same issues facing Christians in the workplace today. This one-day event is not evangelism training, but practical teaching sprinkled with real-life experiences on how to live out one's faith in the workplace in ways that open the door for meaningful conversation and witness to the unreached. The book "How to be a Christian at Work" is used as the accompanying textbook.



What is the expected result?

This is the premier workshop of the God & Work ministry effort – presenting Biblical truths in a business context to "re-awaken" Christians from all walks of life to their true calling in the workplace.

Attendees will be given clear action steps and supporting material from which they can step out to live more effectively for God and His Kingdom, no matter where they work.

Who is this for?

This is for every working Christian at your church.

Who leads the workshop?

The workshop is led by a former business leader and founder of the God & Work ministry, Roland Heersink. Depending on location & budget, theologian and co-author of the book "How to be a Christian at Work", Dr. Szaszi Bene of Tyndale Seminary (Amsterdam) is also available.

Costs

Depending on your preferences, this workshop can be funded from church budgets or paid for via registration fees for the workshop. Workshop fees for 2018 are \$/€ 750 plus expenses on a stand-alone basis; subsidies are available from the God & Work ministry to match available budget if needed.
