

Are You in the Right Job?

Video #2 – Looking Back



In this video, we start answering the question “*Are You in the Right Job?*” by looking back – looking back at how and why you are in the job you are in now, and whether or not God’s purposes for you in that job have been completed.

To help understand if the time is right to move on to another job, or whether you should perhaps stay longer, answer each of the questions below as honestly as you can, in the space provided.

1. How long have you been in your current employer? If you have had multiple jobs with the same employer, then give a short summary of your employment history with that employer.
2. Why did you take your current job? What attracted you to accept it?
3. Do you still feel that your reasoning to take that job is valid today? Or, put another way, would you make the same decision again if circumstances were the same? Why or why not?
4. What do you think God’s purpose might have been for you to take your current job? Did you sense His purpose already when you took the job, or can you only see it now when you look back?
5. Do you think God can still use you in your current job, or do you sense that He can better use you in a new job? Explain your reasoning.
6. On a scale of 0-10 (0 = definitely stay where you are, 5 = unsure, 10 = definitely get a new job) can you give a rating on whether you should take a new job or stay in your current job? Now, write 2-3 sentences to explain the reasoning behind your decision.
