

## **Half-Day Workshop for Managers**

## Why we offer this workshop

Managers in business are responsible not only for their own work, but also for the work and career development of others working for them. While they may receive leadership training at the workplace, we as churches do not generally help these people in their struggle to both serve God and grow as a manager at work.

This workshop is designed to help attendees understand their responsibilities as a Christian in a leadership position in the secular workplace.

# EQUIPPING MANAGERS TO LIVE OUT THEIR FAITH AT WORK

Our objective is to help managers in your church live out their faith and prepares them for ministry at the workplace – reaching those at the workplace for Christ in ways not possible by traditional church programs.

### What is it?

This half-day workshop is a combination of lectures, workshops and group work:

What is the right view of career & promotion?

How to handle failure... and success. What it means to bear witness at work Case studies of tough real-life situations

The workshop is based on the Bible so that we first and foremost see what it means to be a Christian manager at the workplace from God's perspective. The workshop also looks at the challenges managers face in their day to day work – ranging from career ambition, promotion success and failure and the typical dilemmas facing the Christian manager's faith at work.

## What is the expected result?

This workshop provides a basis for managers in church to understand what it means to be a Christian leader in the workplace. Attendees will learn how to effectively bless their teams with a leadership style that honors God and draws others closer to Him.

Optionally, managers can then be paired with senior executives in follow-up mentor program to reinforce these teachings and also help build community among the businesspeople in your church.

## Who is this for?

This workshop is for managers, supervisors and leaders in the business community at your church.

## Who leads the workshop?

The workshop is led by a former global executive, midsize company President, and startup CEO who has transitioned from the full-time workforce to re-emerge as an entrepreneur and founder of the God & Work ministry, Roland Heersink.

## Costs
